Prayer Guide and Prompts:

- Begin with a moment of silence, inviting the Holy Spirit to bring to mind the ways in which you can embody Christ's love in your daily interactions, as Jim did. Ask God to help you notice opportunities to offer genuine care and kindness to those around you.

- Pray for the courage to be vulnerable and authentic in your faith journey, just as the Velveteen Rabbit became 'real' through love. Ask God to reveal areas where you may be hiding behind a facade and to give you the strength to embrace your true identity as His beloved child.

- Reflect on 1 John's message about walking in the light and ask God to search your heart for any darkness or deceit. Pray for transparency in your relationships and for the ability to live in truth, fostering authentic community and spiritual growth.

- Consider the story of the woman with the issue of blood and pray for a heart that mirrors Jesus' compassion and inclusivity. Ask God to help you extend grace and love to those who may feel marginalized or unworthy, breaking down societal and religious barriers in the process.

- Pray for a deeper understanding and acceptance of God's love and grace in your life. Ask God to help you see yourself and others through His eyes—loved, valued, and enough. Pray that this transformative acceptance would liberate you from the world's definitions of worth and purpose.

- Pray for discernment and wisdom in recognizing and participating in the various opportunities for fellowship and service within your community. Ask God to guide you in choosing activities that will help you grow in your faith and contribute to the building of His kingdom.

- Close with a prayer of gratitude for the examples of faith and love you have witnessed, like Jim's life and the biblical accounts shared in the sermon. Ask God to continue to inspire and equip you to live out the Gospel in both word and deed.
