

Fall 2020 App Wesley Ministry Outline *(in response to Covid-19)*

Building Information:

- Masks MUST be worn at all times in the Wesley Building ... same protocol as App State!
- Open to students throughout the day; depending upon renovation and construction, parts of the building will be inaccessible.
- Reminder, No Bathrooms will be accessible.
- Available Room Information:
 - TV Room: 4 people (including Katie and Juston's office space)
 - Coffee Room: 4 people (1 person per table)
 - Chapel: 7 people (1 person per marked area)
 - Total in Building at 1 Given Time: 15
- Sanitation Information:
 - Hand Sanitizing Wipes and Disposing Stations will be available.
 - Diluted Clorox spray is available at each table and room area. When you are done in that space, please spray the table and chair – DO NOT WIPE – and leave to air dry.
 - When the building is closed each night, all door knobs, switches, etc. will be sprayed with the Diluted Clorox mix (again do not wipe, allow to air dry).

- How students should gather:
 - Gather together and be a part of the Monday Prayer & Communion worship service through “same”-dorm groups ... do not enter other apartments or dorms that you do not live in
 - Those in the same apartment complexes may gather together and take part in the service
 - Items to consider:
 - Once you gather with a group, please do not change groups; stay connected with your “location” group through the semester
 - Please track the attendance of the group (per university officials):
 - Name, Appstate Email, Banner ID Number

 - Limit your group number to no-more than 8 people; allowing an “empty chair” for a newcomer, which means, the small group must be capped at 10 individuals (per gathering rules).

 - During the warmer weeks, can Monday Night Prayer & Communion be held with students gathering 6ft apart in the greenspace beside Valborg Theatre?
 - Yes, we will plan a night to do this, the only consideration is that we have to cap our gathering at 25 people, and that limits who is able to participate “live.”

Wednesday Night Worship:

- The scheduled worship band will setup in the chapel in acoustic style, in the marked areas)
- Limit the worship band to 5 people per week, on a rotation, this includes one of the Student Co-Leaders (Regan or Luke) being present to lead call-to-worship, prayer, and announcements
- Other worship leaders (propresenter, video switching) will sit in the Coffee Room at a respective table to lead the livestream worship presentation
- Juston will preach/teach/lead from the “stage” area in the chapel
- Worship will be planned and scheduled through the Worshipplanning.com infrastructure
- Worship Rehearsals:
 - Will be conducted in the Chapel
 - Please limit rehearsals to the folks who will be leading worship in upcoming worship gathering
- The Wesley building will not be open to inside worship/gathering:
 - We do not have access to appropriate air flow / filtration
 - No access to water and/or bathrooms
 - Upstairs space is off-limits due to renovation and construction
- Please track the attendance for the following – Rehearsals, Wednesday Night Worship, Pre-Worship Meal Gathering:

- FAQ:
 - The Chapel can only hold 7 people ... please limit the worship band each week.
 - Can students gather 6ft apart in the greenspace beside Valborg Theatre and watch live?
 - Per University, students may gather in groups of no more than 10 people, spaced out 6ft apart to gather together in the green space beside Valborg Theatre ... face masks must be worn.
 - What availability does Boone UMC have for outdoor worship space and hardwire internet connection to livestream?
 - We may use outdoor space at Boone UMC, however, we cannot carpool. Events must be scheduled through the Boone UMC Office, and we must follow Boone UMC protocol. It may be best to only use this space to pre-record worship offerings.
 - Is space available for those that need the Wesley building for a more reliable internet connection?
 - Yes, the TV Room and Coffee Room are available on a first-come, first-serve basis at the marked tables and areas.

 - Limit your in-person group number to no-more than 8 people; allowing an “empty chair” for a newcomer, which means, the small group must be capped at 10 individuals (per gathering rules).
